Tuition for the 2010-2011 is going up \$25.00 per student, per year. For grade's 1-6: 1st child \$1,275.00, 2nd child \$1,025.00, 3rd child \$775.00. Kindergarten is \$1,600.00 for a parish member and \$1,825.00 for a non parish member. Pre-K is \$1,375.00 for a parish member and \$1,600.00 for a non parish member.
