Send it back to school in your Friday Folder, and we will laminate it. The flags will be placed at different locations on the Walk-A-Thon. Everyone stops and offers prayers for the petitions listed on the flag. You do not have to contribute money to the Walk-A-Thon to put a name on the flag!

We ask that you consider writing to your relatives (actually the children should be doing this) for a possible donation.
