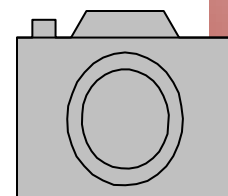

**TRUNK or Treat**

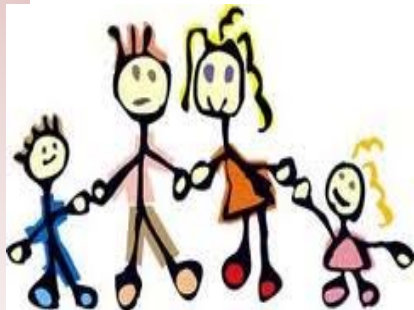
Where: Minnesota School of Business
